

Scholarship for ICPC members

The Iowa Conservation and Preservation Consortium (ICPC) is offering two \$500 reimbursement scholarships to the Campbell Center for Historic Preservation Studies in Mount Carroll, Illinois, or Northern States Conservation Center on-line classes, or to the Midwest Art Conservation Center in Minneapolis. Those eligible to apply are **Iowa residents or college students in Iowa** working or who have worked in a museum, historical society, library, archive, genealogical society library, government record office, or other institution that preserves the history and culture of Iowa.

Eligible applicants must be an individual member of the ICPC, or from an organization that has an institutional membership with ICPC. The scholarship winners must demonstrate that the classes taken will be utilized within the state of Iowa. Each winner is expected to provide either a tip sheet or a presentation at a future ICPC event.
